- Research, plant evaluation and comparative trials with herbaceous perennials and woody plants






Horticulture: Definition & Branches



Many Possibilties to Elect and Specialize


- There are currently 16 elective modules to choose from in the summer semester, with a maximum

- There are currently 26 elective modules to choose from in the winter semester, with a maximum of five per semester, e.g.

 - Herbs, Spices and Mushrooms


